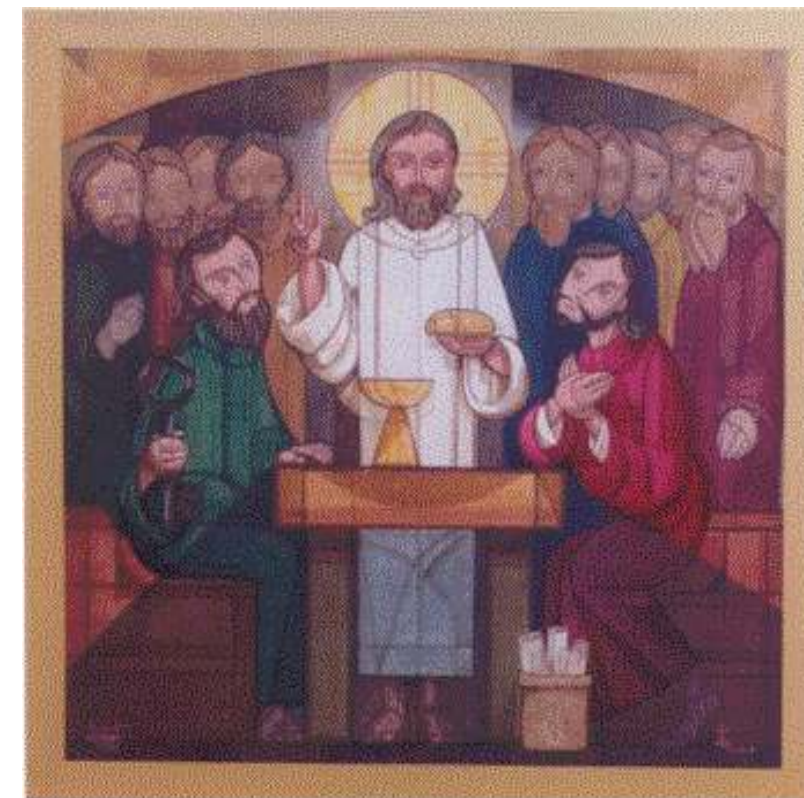
## Stamp Out Hunger
