

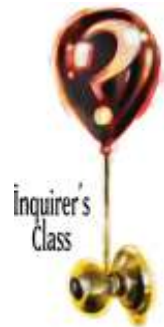

So, how do you participate?

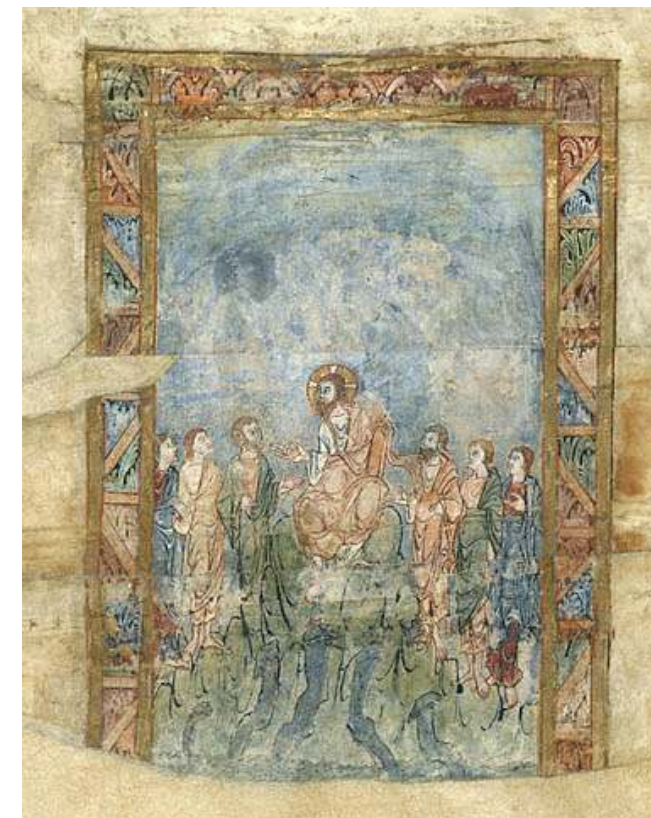
- ▶ First, check the bulletin board in the Welcome Center for needed food items.
